About the CRRC

The Cat and Rabbit Rescue Centre was established in 1986 and is a registered charity. Each year the Centre helps and supports over 1,000 cats, rabbits and guinea pigs by taking in unwanted, abandoned and stray animals, offering low cost neutering vouchers and helping farms, hospitals & factories with the trapping and neutering of feral colonies. This is achieved through a range of provisions such as re-homing pens, indoor and outdoor hutches and runs, intensive care unit, veterinary facilities and a recovery room.



The Centre's current running costs are just over £300,000 per year, but more is needed to continue to help those who we know so desperately need us.

Make Your Will Count

Leave a Legacy in your Will. Even the smallest amount of money can make all the difference to the lives of the animals we often rely on as our companions when we are alone.

Do you have the Will to make sure your pet is looked after when you are no longer able? Loving an animal means taking care of its future too.

You do not need to write a new Will to add a Legacy for your pet, you can add the bequest by codicil.

- Do not alter the original will.
- Type the codicil, starting below the signatures on the last page of the will.
- Sign your codicil with the same number of witnesses you were required to have for the original will.
- Staple the codicil to the original will.
- Make and attach a copy of the codicil to each copy of your will.

Leaving a Legacy to Charity

There are four types of Legacy you could consider:

1. A specific sum of money – ***Pecuniary Legacy***
2. What is left after all your other wishes have been carried out and expenses met – ***Residuary Legacy***
3. A particular item of value – ***Specific Bequest***
4. A gift to be made only upon death of the person you first intended to benefit – ***Conditional Bequest***
