

Cat & Kitten Adoption Fee

Any cat or kitten adopted from the CRRC will:

- have been neutered
- have had at least its first vaccination for flu and enteritis
- up-to-date flea and worming treatment
- have been microchipped
- have been health checked by our vet
- is covered by Pet plan Veterinary insurance for up to 4 weeks

An **adoption fee of £70.00** is required for each cat or kitten.

This is less than \(\frac{1}{3} \) of the full cost, so any further donation is very much appreciated.

Leaving with your Cat or Kitten

All domestic cats and kittens leaving the CRRC must:

- leave with a collar and id on
- be transported in a **proper carrier** (cardboard or corrugated plastic is not permitted). These products are for sale on site (new and secondhand).
