Animal Assistant Volunteer

Volunteers are a part of the beating heart of our charity and without your help we would not be able to continue to assist all the animals we support. There are two types of Animal Assistant volunteer roles.

As a morning (10am— noon) Animal Assistant Volunteer your general responsibilities will be to:

- Assist the animal care staff with their daily tasks - Including anything from sanitizing pens to helping with paperwork.
- Help the animal care staff emptying & cleaning the litter trays - this is not the most glamorous job, but what comes in must come out.
- Animal Handling can then be done after your morning shift if you wish

As an afternoon (1pm—3.30pm) Animal Assistant Volunteer your role is to handle our animals to improve their socialization - The most shy and nervous animals are the ones that need your time the most, even if it may just be sitting next to them and let them come to you. We split the handling as follows:

- Cats - You will normally provide socialization to 6 pens per shift between 1pm—3.30pm
- Rabbit and guinea pigs between 1pm—3.30pm

As a volunteer you must:

- Provide us times that you are available to volunteer weekly or monthly and always be on time - it is important to us that you are available at the same time slots continuously.
- Abide by our confidentiality and health and safety policies.
