Cat & Kitten Adoption Fee

Any **cat or kitten** adopted from the CRRC will:

- have been neutered
- have had at least its first vaccination for flu and enteritis
- up-to-date flea and worming treatment
- have been microchipped
- have been health checked by our vet
- is covered by Pet plan Veterinary insurance for up to 4 weeks

An **adoption fee of £90.00** is required for each cat.

An **adoption fee of £100.00** is required for each kitten.

An **adoption fee of £50.00** is required for senior cats over 12 years.

This is less than $\frac{1}{3}$ of the full cost, so any further donation is very much appreciated.

Leaving with your Cat or Kitten

All domestic cats and kittens leaving the CRRC must:

- leave with a **collar and id on**
- be transported in a **proper carrier** (cardboard or corrugated plastic is not permitted). These products are for sale on site (new and secondhand).

Typical Vet Prices

The following prices are an average as at **Jan 2017**, to provide an indication of the typical costs involved in ensuring a cat is ready for rehoming from the CRRC.
