Over 35 years of love

The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre was created to rescue, rehabilitate and find forever homes for animals in need.

Our founders had an unrivalled passion for animals. What began as a small, local rescue and fostering effort quickly grew into something much bigger.

In the early 1980s, with a mission to rescue cats, rabbits, and guinea pigs, a quiet home near Chichester was purchased, complete with several acres of land. It offered the space and opportunity to help even more animals in desperate need, and marked the beginning of what would become The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre.

With the support of dedicated volunteers, our founders worked around the clock, 365 days a year to care for unwanted, abandoned, feral and neglected animals and to continuously improve the facilities of what had then become an established rescue centre and charity.

Today, we honour and uphold our founders' hardworking ethos and dedication to animal welfare.

Due to ever-growing demand, The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre has expanded its facilities to accommodate up to 400 animals. Our purpose-built rooms provide safety and comfort, often to animals who may have never experienced either before. We also have an onsite veterinary centre, where our team can carry out vital surgeries, administer treatments, and provide ongoing medical care.

In addition, our dedicated Mother & Baby Unit offers specialised support for pregnant cats, new mothers, and their kittens, giving them the best possible start in life.

We've always believed every animal should have the chance at a good life. That's why we never put a healthy animal down, and we welcome animals of all ages, health conditions, and temperaments into our rescue centre.

We've come a long way since our small beginnings, but we continue to serve and support local communities. Since 1986, we've helped over 40,000 animals across West Sussex and Hampshire and rehome around 1000 each year.

Thanks to our supporters who left a gift to us in their Will, we were able to provide urgent medication needed to treat the parasite. Although the parasite's damage could not be reversed, we worked tirelessly to provide her with an excellent quality of life and showered her with love during her stay with us.

Upsy Daisy now happily lives with a member of our dedicated Animal Care Team, who fell in love with her whilst caring for her at our rescue centre.

On a cold, bleak night, we received a call for help for an injured cat found on the side of the road, hit by a car and ignored by passing drivers for

> When we found the poor boy meowing for help, his diagnosis was not good; he had a broken leg, smashed jaw, he was struggling to breathe and his eye was hanging from its socket.

We brought him to the safety of The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre and started treatment right away including surgery to remove his poorly eye and amputate his leg that was

beyond repair plus medication to ease his pain and stop infection. Amazingly, despite all he endured, he purred continuously from the time he arrived. We named him Caellum, meaning 'brave warrior'.

Thanks to the supporters who left us a gift in their will, Caellum was able to live out his remaining years exploring The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre's several acres and offices, surrounded by love.

What do you want to be remembered for?

Having a Will brings peace of mind, knowing that your loved ones and the causes you care about will be looked after when you're gone.

As an animal lover, it's only natural to want to continue supporting animals, even when you're no longer here to do so.

You might be thinking that with family and friends to consider, there's no room to leave a gift to charity. But even a small portion, just 1% of what's left after your loved ones are provided for, can make a real and lasting difference to animals in need.

At The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre, we don't receive government funding, so we rely solely on the generosity of supporters and gifts in Wills to allow us to continue our work giving animals the **second chances they all deserve.**

Over 50%

of funds we need for vital surgeries, rescue and rehoming operations, and day-to-day care comes from gifts in Wills

Our care starts the moment we receive a call for an animal in need and continues even after they've found their forever home.

- Every year, we provide over 7000 vital medical treatments to injured and poorly animals, including lifesaving operations
- We welcome around 1000 cats, rabbits, and guinea pigs into our care annually, each one with a unique story
- We've saved hundreds of animals from being euthanised for a variety of reasons ranging from medical to behavioural issues and are proud to have found them loving, forever homes



How to remember CRRC in your Will

Making or updating your Will is easier than you think.

Value your estate

Your estate is the total amount of assets you have, minus any debts.

You can get an idea of what your estate will be worth by making a list of your assets, such as property you own, savings, investments and other personal belongings less any debts such as mortgage, loans or credit card balance.

Decide who you want to provide for

Think about how you want your family, friends, and your favourite causes to benefit from your Will.

Make sure your estate is divided to take care of the people and charities you love, in the way you want. You can give specific items to individuals or you can simply divide your estate between a number of people and charities.

Leave a gift to The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre

The best gift you can give is a chance for animals in need.

Gifts left to us in Wills are vital to our work rescuing, rehabilitating, and rehoming animals in need. If you decide to leave a gift to us in your Will, make sure to include our full name, address, and registered charity number. You can also write your Will online for free. Find out how to do this on the next page.

Choose your executors

These are the people responsible for carrying out your wishes when you're gone.
You can choose friends, family members, or solicitors to act as the executor of your estate.

Ask a solicitor to draw up your Will

We recommend using a solicitor to ensure your Will is valid, accurately reflects your wishes, and can be stored safely. Solicitors can help you with any updates you may need to make to your Will throughout your life.

Choosing which type of gift to leave

There are three main types of gift that you can choose to leave in your Will.

Residuary Gift

A residuary gift is a share or percentage of the value of your assets, such as property and savings, after all other payments have been made (e.g. debts, gifts, tax expenses). The advantage of a residuary gift is that it won't lose its value over time due to inflation.

Pecuniary Gift

A pecuniary gift is a specific amount of money, which can be any amount you choose.

Specific Gifts

If you'd like to leave a particular item, such as jewellery, a family heirloom or even property, this is known as a specific gift.



Wording for your Will

Should you decide to remember The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre in your Will, you may want to share this suggested wording with your solicitor to help ensure your wishes are made clear.

Option 1: A Residuary Gift

(i) I give to The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre, Holborrow Lodge, Chalder Lane, Sidlesham, Chichester PO20 7RJ (registered charity no 1197958), the residue (or % share of the residue) of my estate absolutely and I direct that the proceeds may be used for the general purposes of The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre.

(ii) I direct that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre shall be a sufficient discharge for my executors. Option 2: A Pecuniary Gift or Specific Item

(i) I give to The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre, Holborrow Lodge, Chalder Lane, Sidlesham, Chichester PO20 7RJ (registered charity no 1197958), (i) (free of tax) the sum of £___ OR (ii) (free of tax and coast of transfer) the gift of my [short description of specific item given] and I direct that the proceeds may be used for the general purposes of The Cat and Rabbit Rescue Centre.

(ii) I direct that the receipt of the duly authorised officer of The Cat & Rabbit Rescue Centre shall be a sufficient discharge for my executors.
